- 1 Puncture tube with the back side of the cap and squeeze into plastic or glass bowl. Do not use metal, as it can have a reaction. There are lines on the tube indicating 1/2 oz each.
- 2 Measure developer in a plastic measuring cup and mix with a tint brush or plastic fork. Do not use a metal fork. Tightly recap color and developer to extend the life and quality.
- 3 For dark colors, protect hairline with hair wax or coconut oil. Wipe off any that gets on the hair.
- 4 Dip the tip of the brush into color then wipe excess off one side by swiping across the bowl.
- 5 Using the tail of the brush to section, start application along center part and hairline first, and apply to new growth only. Create 1/4" parting with the tail of the brush and apply to the next section.
- 6 Continue working around the head. You might choose to just do your hairline and part to hold you over, or get help applying to the back since it can be challenging.
- 7 Once application is complete, time for 30 minutes, 45 for gray coverage.
- 8 Shampoo out and condition. Bye bye roots!
